On January 23, 2013 the Harbor City Neighborhood Council Board passed a motion in support of the Del Lago 204 unit garden style apartment development located at 1450-1500 W. Pacific Coast Highway and the proposed Zone Change and Site Plan Review application.

The proposed development of high quality new rental housing will revitalize the former site of two dilapidated car dealerships. There is a tremendous need for high quality rental housing in the community. Our Board supports the project because it will improve the subject property, serve as a catalyst for reinvestment in the area, and strengthen local property values.
