On June 26, 2013, a representative from the Starbucks' team attended the Harbor City Neighborhood Council Governing Board Meeting and provided an overview of the proposed Starbucks' Drive-Thru project at the corner of Lomita Boulevard and Western Avenue. The representative explained that they are applying for a Conditional Use Permit to modify the hours of operation to 5am-midnight, 7 days a week.

The Board was informed that this will be a company owned store that will be managed well and provide local employment opportunities. Board members were very supportive of the proposed project and were willing to endorse the CUP and hours of operation.
