

# Ad Hoc Committee on Homelessness Meeting Report

Meeting held on Thursday, August 11 at 6:30pm.

We formed two board approved sub-committees. One is a committee to assist Harbor City businesses to acquire No Trespassing signs. The other committee is to reach out to Universities to work with LAPD's Quality of Life Team in the Harbor City area.

We spoke about the need of more trained volunteer to help the homeless who are transitioning into permanent housing, the need of more crisis housing centers. And the need of more housing for section 8 vouchers. We also were informed of two programs: GOOH (Get Out Of Homelessness) and Get A Life Program.

Our newly assigned SLO Lopez was in attendance. He did let us know he is aware of the RV's parking around Harbor City. He is talking to the people and telling them to move their RV. He is being active in the community. Committee did ask about permits for RV's belonging to residents in that way the RV's that do not belong will get ticketed.

We also spoke about the Welcome Home Project which the Mayor's office is promoting. There was also mention of a possible Homeless Outreach event to go along with Laundry Love (a day of washing clothing on Frampton and PCH).

Overall, we need volunteers to help Harbor Division's Quality of life team and we need volunteers to help those who are transitioning to permanent housing. We need to be proactive and not complainers.
