The meeting was called to order by Sydney Baune at 6:00PM. There were 2 HCNC board members and four stakeholders present.

There was no public comment on non-agenda items.

A date to organize and inventory items in the storage unit is still pending until it can be set with the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment.

The Annual Holiday Lights Contest was well attended and awards were given in each Harbor City Area.

The Winter Wonderland Event was a success. Attendance exceeded expectations, an estimated 2000-3000 people attended.

Stakeholder Appreciation Night; Approximately 30 t-shirts were given to stake holders. Stakeholders also picked up yard signs they signed up for at Winter Wonderland.

City Lights members Tim Tucker, "Scotty" Howard Scott and Kim Graham were approved to each receive a Recognition of Outstanding Citizenship Award by a vote of: 8 approved, 1 abstention.

Tom and Kathy Houston were nominated for ROC Awards. The vote was unanimous.

The committee voted unanimously to approve up to \$10,000 for the Concert Series by the Lake (formerly the Harbor City Music Festival) which will be held over the summer at Ken Malloy Harbor Regional Park.

The parade for the Division Champion Narbonne Football team may be cancelled due to lack of interest from the team.

LAUSD is willing to discuss distributing of Harbor City NC meeting information through the schools' monthly newsletters and weekly informational packets.
