We support the Mayor to amend his proposed budget and cut the LAPD budget of \$100-150 million from the Department's \$1.86 billion budget is commendable. Further cuts should be made in overtime pay for policing the homeless, safeguarding city infrastructure for community events and providing security detail for elected officials, Department staff and in our schools. We recommend that the city invests in reforming the LAPD and commit to repairing trust and confidence between the LAPD and the public it serves.
