Council

- [20-1494](#): LAHSA's Rehousing Services System Report (Recovery Plan). This update will include data on outcomes from its rehousing services system work, outreach and prevention efforts, in addition to an update on LAHSA's Ad Hoc Committee on Governance. Rehouse 15k of the most vulnerable.
- [20-0862](#) (ITEM 9): Instructions regarding the Citywide senior meal program. We will extend the program to the end of September. Dep't of Aging is instructed to report back on a more cost effective model.
- [20-0990](#) (ITEM 14): Motion - mandatory training on Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and anti-bias, for all members of the NC's. This would be led by DONE and the new Human & Civil Rights Commission.
- [17-0360](#): Consideration of a motion directing the Board of Public Works, LADWP, Bureau of Sanitation to report on how they support environmental justice in disadvantaged communities.
- [20-179](#): Ken Malloy Harbor Regional Park – Proposed CD15 Tiny Homes Village Project at 1221 Figueroa Place. Term not to exceed three years.
- [20-180](#): Proposed Agreement with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk for use of 45 Facilities to Host Vote Drop Boxes to Collect Ballots from the Public– Approval of Plans to Install Vote Drop Boxes
